On preparing the estimates for the financial year 2007/08 it was estimated that the General Reserve would amount to £500,707 as at 31 March 2007. The actual Reserve as at 31 March 2007 was £506,057 and it is estimated that this Surplus will be in the region of £505,119 as at 31 March 2008, after transferring £270,000 to the Fixed Plant Renewals Fund.

**3. DRAINAGE RATES/SPECIAL LEVIES FOR 2008/2009**

The following table shows the rate/levies for last year, and 3 rate/levy options for this year based on estimated net expenditure. Option 1 shows the actual rate/levies requirement of 3.37%. Option 2 shows a rate increase of 2.92%, which equates to a 3.00% increase for SHDC - given the shift in their proportion of aggregate annual value arising from development during the course of the year (which is largely controlled by SHDC). Option 3 shows an inflationary rise of 4.20%, which equates to a 4.28% increase for SHDC - given the shift in their proportion of aggregate annual value arising from development during the course of the year. Option 2 is recommended and Members attention is drawn to the 5 year indicative forecast shown overleaf.

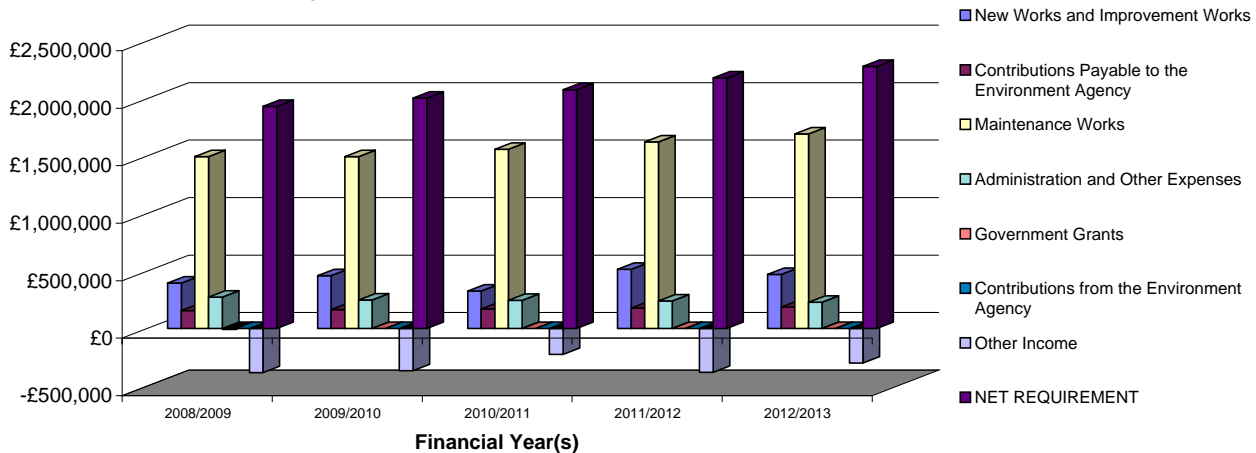
